The European Cup Teams was owned by European Tenpin Bowling Federation.

Each edition of the championships was awarded to a host, which in each case was a member federation. The host organized the event in co-operation with ETBF's Officials.

The athletes had to be maximum 18 years of age, while no lowest age limit existed.

The first edition of the European Youth Cup Teams was conducted in 1995 in Netanya, Israel with 35 girls and 46 boys from 8 different federations taking part.

The championship was conducted in total 5 times, every second year in the odd numbered years from 1995 until 2003.

The championship disappeared because it was decided to conduct a European Youth Championships every year instead of every second year as of 2004.

The main reason for the change was a wish from many federations to be able to bowl for more than just one set of medals in bigger championships with long travels and many accommodation days per person.
