<b>Total</b>	<b>20.000</b>
<b>First 300 game</b> For the first 300 game in the tournament, the athlete will be awarded a high performance ball. All athletes scoring a 300 game will receive a Leisureplex 300 pen.	
<b>The women's prize</b> The women's prize is an extra prize, which always is awarded, no matter the ranking of the highest woman in the tournament.	
<b>Seniors Prizes</b> The senior competition is open to athletes born on 1 January 1969 or earlier. Age verification is required. The senior prizes are extra prizes, which always are awarded, no matter the ranking of the highest seniors in the tournament.	

<b>Tournament format</b>
<b>Qualification</b> Entries, 6 games Re-entries, 6 games Desperado squad, 1 game
<b>62 athletes will qualify for the final steps from five categories</b>
<u>Category A (4 athletes)</u> Athletes positioned 1-4 in the general qualification standing. If an athlete is qualified from A and one or more other categories; the qualification from A has the highest priority.
<u>Category B (4 athletes)</u> Athletes positioned 5-8 in the general qualification standing. If an athlete is qualified from B and one or more other categories; the qualification from B has the highest priority.
<u>Category C (45 athletes)</u> The 45 highest positioned athletes in the general qualification standing, not already qualified from one of the categories A or B. If an athlete is qualified from C and (A or B), the next positioned in the C standing will qualify. If an athlete is qualified both from C and D; the qualification from C has the highest priority.
<u>Category D (6 athletes)</u> Athletes positioned 1-6 in a separate standing including 5 squads, which is Squad 1 Extra and Squad 1-4. If an athlete is qualified from D and any other category, the next positioned in the D standing will qualify.
<u>Category E (3 athletes)</u> Athletes positioned 1-3 in the Desperado Squad.
<b>The division of qualified athletes in final steps</b> The 4 athletes from Category A will start the final in step 3, seeding 1-4. The 4 athletes from Category B will start the final in step 2. The 27 highest positioned athletes in Category C will bowl in Group 1 of the final step 1. The 18 lowest positioned athletes from category C, the 6 athletes from Category D and the 3 athletes from Category E (in total 27 athletes) will bowl in Group 2 of the final step 1.
<b>Final step 1</b> 54 athletes will play 3 games, starting from scratch

Athletes positioned 1-28 are qualified for the final step 2

Athletes positioned 29-54 will be ranked 37-62 according to their position in the final step 1

### Final step 2

32 athletes will play 3 games, starting from scratch

Athletes positioned 1-12 are qualified for the final step 3, seeded 5-16.

Athletes positioned 13-32 will be ranked 17-36 according to their position in the final step 2

### Specifications for the remaining part of the final

Each step will consist of matches, decided over 2 games total pin fall.

The highest seeded athlete will meet the lowest seeded athlete; the second highest seeded athlete will meet the second lowest seeded athlete etc.

Athletes will keep their seeding numbers in the remaining steps of the final.

### Final step 3

8 matches

8 winners will continue to the final step 4

8 losers will be ranked 9-16 according to their seeding

### Final step 4

4 matches

4 winners will continue to the final step 5

4 losers will be ranked 5-8 according to their seeding

### Final step 5

2 matches

2 winners will continue to the final step 6

2 losers will be ranked 3-4 according to their seeding

### Final step 6

1 match

The loser will be ranked 2

The winner will be ranked 1

### Senior Tournament format

#### Senior Finals Qualification Criteria

The top 4 seniors based on their ranked position after the Final Step 5, or their position in the general qualification standing, for those not qualified through to the final steps, will be seeded 1-4 for the Senior Semi Finals.

In the event that a senior athlete has also qualified for Final Step 6 then this place will go to the next senior based on the qualification criteria.

#### Senior Semi Final

2 matches, 2 games total pin fall to count

2 winners will continue to the Senior Final

The 2 losers will be ranked 3-4 in the senior-standing according to their seeding

#### Senior Final

1 match, 2 games total pin fall to count

The loser will be ranked 2 in the senior-standing

The winner will be ranked 1 in the senior-standing

### Tournament tie rules

#### Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still

exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

### Desperado

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

### Final Step 1-2

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step will be broken by playing a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1-2, a procedure similar to the procedure for the qualification will be followed.

### Final Step 3-6 and Seniors Semi-Finals and Final

In case of a tie in a match, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

### The highest game

If the highest game is scored by more than one athlete, the prize will be split equally among these athletes.

### Lane assignments and lane movements

Lane draws	Randomly done by the organizer
Athletes per pair in squads	2-4 per pair depending on squad sizes
Frequency of movement	After each game
Movement method	Two pairs to the right
Number of lanes to move	Four
