Quarter Final Men

32 players will play 4 games starting from scratch

Top 16 continues to the Semi Final

Semi Final Women

12 players will play 4 games starting from scratch

Top 8 continues to the round robin Final

Semi Final Men

20 players will play 4 games starting from scratch

Top 8 continues to the round robin Final

Final (similar for both genders)

8 players will play a 7 games round robin with 50 % the pin fall after the Semi Final carried forward. There will be 30 points for a won game and 15 points for a tied game

Tournament tie rules

In case of a tie in any stage of the tournament, the highest ranked athlete will be the athlete with the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest ranked athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game, then the athlete with the highest third last game etc.

In the round robin competition, games are compared without bonus points, when ties are broken. If a tie still exists after comparing scores without (game) bonus, the tie rule of highest last game etc. will be used.

In the Turbo qualification applies: the lowest age-bonus has been placed. If that is still the same, then the player with the highest qualification in the normal ranking is placed.

In Scratch qualification the player with the highest last game excl. Bonus is placed etc
