



## Press Release 04: Kegel-ETBF Agreement 2012-2014

A well working partnership between Kegel and ETBF has existed already seven years, beginning with a one year agreement followed by two agreements of each three years of duration.

The actual three year's agreement terminates at the end of 2011, but the cooperation will continue into a new three year's period.

It is a pleasure for the Presidium of the European Tenpin Bowling Federation to be able to inform, that we have entered into the fourth consecutive agreement with Kegel, and to announce **Kegel to be the Official Lane Maintenance Partner for ETBF** in 2012-2014.

The main objectives for the agreement is lane maintenance at ETBF Championships, lane maintenance at selected EBT Stops and in addition some other services provided by Kegel.

Lane maintenance provided by Kegel is mandatory for championship hosts and in the agreement period ETBF will conduct a total of 9 championships, which is 2 European Women Championships (2012 and 2014), 1 European Men Championships (2012), 3 annual European Youth Championships and 3 annual European Champion Cups.

For organizers of EBT Platinum Tournaments, EBT Gold Tournaments and EBT Silver Tournaments, lane maintenance provided by Kegel is an option, while organizers of EBT Satellite Tournaments can contact Kegel for lane maintenance advices over the distance.

Also continuing in the new agreement is the availability of the Kegel LaneMapper, a very efficient and accurate tool to measure the lane topography in any bowling centers hosting an ETBF Championships, or in any center wishing to obtain the official ETBF Centre Certification.

It is a clear policy for ETBF to provide professional lane maintenance for its championships and main EBT Tournaments. The ETBF Presidium is therefore very pleased and satisfied for the continued partnership with Kegel for 2012-2014.

Each of the organizers will in a few days receive detailed information about the new lane maintenance agreement and the possibilities it opens for the organizers.
