European Intermediate Cup: A Historical Review / Page 1

The European Intermediate Cup was owned by European Tenpin Bowling Federation.

Each edition of the championships was awarded to a host, which in each case was a member federation. The host organized the event in co-operation with ETBF's Officials.

The athletes had to be maximum 23 years of age, while no lowest age limit existed.

The first edition of the European Intermediate Cup was conducted in 1987 in Dublin, Ireland with 25 girls and 35 boys from 7 different federations taking part.

The championship was conducted 2 times; in 1987 and in 1989, where after it was removed from the program in Europe, due to a lack of interest among the member federations.
