World Senior Championships: A Historical Review / Page 1

The World Senior Championships is owned by World Bowling.

Each edition of the championships is awarded to a host, which can be a federation, a public organization or a company. The host organizes the event in co-operation with WB's Officials.

Athletes must be 50 years of age or above in the year of the championship.

The first edition of the World Singles Championships was conducted in 2013 in Las Vegas, USA with 123 male and 90 female athletes from 33 different federations taking part.

The championships is conducted every second year in the odd numbered years.

Each federation can send four men and four women to the championships.

The disciplines for both genders are Singles, Doubles, Team of Four, All Event and Masters.
