International Bowling Federation (IBF) is divided in five geographical zones as follows:

- The American Zone / Pan-American Confederation (PANAM)
- The Asian Zone / Asian Bowling Federation (ABF)
- The European Zone / European Bowling Federation (EBF)
- The African Zone / Bowling Federation of Africa (BFA)
- The Oceania Zone / Oceania Bowling Federation (OBF)

The geographical area of EBF includes the continent of Europe, the British Isles, Israel and the islands of the North Atlantic.

The purpose of EBF is as follows;

1. To further and perpetuate interest in tenpin bowling in conformity with the constitution of World Bowling and to encourage good relations between the members within the EBF geographical area.
2. To encourage the use of IBF's Playing Rules within its area and to require that these rules will be followed in all tournaments approved by EBF.
3. To grant approval to international tenpin bowling tournaments within its area.
4. To establish and further develop a European Bowling Tour, including top tournaments, primarily conducted within its area
5. To conduct different kinds of European Championships in accordance with the EBF Constitution and EBF Rules.
6. To establish special rules for EBF's activities provided they are not contrary to the regulations of IBF.
7. To prescribe dues to help finance the EBF activities as authorised by the congress.
8. To represent EBF in IBF in accordance with its Statutes.
