10 athletes will qualify directly for the final step 3, which is athletes positioned 1-10 in the qualification standing

10 athletes will qualify directly for the final step 2, which is athletes positioned 11-20 in the qualification standing

30 athletes will qualify directly for the final step 1, which is:

Athletes positioned 21-38 in the qualification standing

Athletes positioned 1-3 in a separate standing for the squads conducted on 2-3 July

Athletes positioned 1-5 in a separate standing for the squads conducted on 4-5 July

Athletes positioned 1-4 in the desperado standing

In cases of athletes from the separate 2-3 July standing is positioned in the interval 1-38 in the qualification standing, the next positioned athlete in the 2-3 July standing will qualify

In cases of athletes from the separate 4-5 July standing is positioned in the interval 1-38 in the qualification standing or 1-3 in the separate 2-3 July standings, the next positioned athlete in the 4-5 July standing will qualify

Final step 1

30 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.

Top 10 will qualify for the final step 2

The athletes not continuing to the final step 2 will be ranked 31-50 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 1

Final step 2

20 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.

Top 10 will qualify for the final step 3

The athletes not continuing to the final step 3 will be ranked 21-30 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 2

Final step 3

20 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.

Top 10 will qualify for the final step 4

The athletes not continuing to the final step 4 will be ranked 11-20 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 3

Final step 4

10 athletes will play 4 game with the total pin fall after the final step 3 carried forward

Top 3 will qualify for the final step 5

The athletes not continuing to the final step 5 will be ranked 4-10 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 4

Final Step 5

There will be 2 stepladder matches

Stepladder match 1

The athlete seeded 3 and the athlete seeded 2 will play a one-game match

The loser of the match will be ranked 3

Stepladder match 2

The winner of match 1 and the athlete seeded 1 will play a one-game match

The loser of the match will be ranked 2

The winner of the match will be ranked 1

Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the lowest game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the two lowest games etc.

Desperado

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a 9th and 10th frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

Final Step 1-4

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step, and ties for any of the first 3 positions in step 4, will be broken by playing a 9th and 10th frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1-4, a procedure similar to the procedure for the qualification will be followed.

Final step 5

In case of a tie in any match, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

Lane assignments and lane movements

Lane draws	By the tournament management
Athletes per pair in squads	Four
Frequency of movement	After each game
Movement method	The whole pair moves to the right
Number of lanes to move	Two
