<b>48 athletes will qualify for the final steps as follows:</b> A: Athletes positioned 1-36 in the qualification standing B: Athletes positioned 1-3 in a separate standing for the squads conducted on 29-30 June C: Athletes positioned 1-5 in a separate standing for the squads conducted on 1-2 July D: Athletes positioned 1-4 in the desperado standing
Athletes are qualified in the order A-B-C-D

Athletes positioned 1-16 in the qualification are qualified for the final step 2, seeded 1-16  
All other 32 qualified athletes are qualified for the final step 1

### Final step 1

32 athletes will play 6 games starting from scratch

Top 16 will qualify for the final step 2, seeded 17-32

Athletes not continuing to the final step 2 will be ranked 33-48 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 1

### Matching for the final step 2-6

The highest seeded athlete will be matched against the lowest seeded athlete

### Final step 2

There will be 16 matches, best of three games

The losers of the matches will be ranked 17-32 according to their seeding

### Final step 3

There will be 8 matches, best of three games

The losers of the matches will be ranked 9-16 according to their seeding

### Final step 4

There will be 4 matches, best of three games

The losers of the matches will be ranked 5-8 according to their seeding

### Final step 5

There will be 2 one game matches

The losers of the matches will be ranked 3-4 according to their seeding

### Final step 6

There will be a one game match

The loser of the match will be ranked 2

The winner of the match will be ranked 1

## Tournament tie rules

### Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

### Desperado

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

### Final Step 1-4

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step will be broken by playing a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1, a procedure similar to the procedure for the qualification will be followed.

### Final Step 5

In case of a tie in any match, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played until tie is broken.
