Tournament format

Qualification squads: 6 games American style

Step 1: (Semifinals) for all categories with 25% of the participants and a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 8 players per category from the final weekend.

Plus Top 1 of each category, playing in the first weekend squads (Entry+Re-entry), qualifies automatically for the semifinals.

Plus Top 1 of each category from the Desperado (1 game) standing, qualifies for the semifinals

If no Desperado is played in any division, the Top 9 players per category from the final weekend qualifies for the semifinals.

Top 4 in each category will continue to Step 2.

Each step will start from scratch

(Step 1: 3 games - Step 2: 2 games - Step 3: 2 games)

Step 2: The fourth-placed plays against the first-placed, the third-placed against the second-placed. Each match 2 games.

The winners of the matches are in the finals (each category)

Step 3: Finals: The finalists (each category) play 2 games.

The player with the highest pinfall overall is the winner of the Tour stop

Tournament tie rules

Qualification

In case of a tie, the athlete with the highest last game will be highest ranked. In case of a further tie, the athlete with the second highest last game will be highest ranked etc.

The Final Steps

In case of a tie among two or more athletes, for a position that is decisive for a continuation to the next final step, 9th and 10th frame roll off will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.
