Athletes qualified from A will be seeded 1-24 according to their qualification position Athletes qualified from B-G will be seeded 25-30 according to an internal standing among the 6, based on their highest qualification series

The athlete qualified from H will be seeded 31

The athlete qualified from I will be seeded 32

Athletes will keep their seeding numbers throughout all final steps

Qualified for final steps

Athletes positioned 1-8 in the qualification are qualified for the final step 3 Athletes positioned 9-16 in the qualification are qualified for the final step 2 All other 16 qualified athletes are qualified for the final step 1

Matches in the Final Step 1-4
