Seeding numbers

Athletes qualified from A will be seeded 1-24 according to their qualification position
Athletes qualified from B-G will be seeded 25-30 according to an internal standing among the 6, based on their highest qualification series
The athlete qualified from H will be seeded 31
The athlete qualified from I will be seeded 32
Athletes will keep their seeding numbers throughout all final steps

Qualified for final steps

Athletes positioned 1-8 in the qualification are qualified for the final step 3
Athletes positioned 9-16 in the qualification are qualified for the final step 2
All other 16 qualified athletes are qualified for the final step 1

Matches in the Final Step 1-4

Each match will be a best of three games match
The highest seeded athlete will meet the lowest seeded athlete; the second highest seeded athlete will meet the second lowest seeded athlete etc.

Final Step 1

16 athletes will play 8 matches
The winners of the matches will continue to the Final Step 2
The losers of the matches will be ranked 25-32 according to their seeding

Final Step 2

16 athletes will play 8 matches
The winners of the matches will continue to the Final Step 3
The losers of the matches will be ranked 17-24 according to their seeding

Final Step 3

16 athletes will play 8 matches
The winners of the matches will continue to the Final Step 4
The losers of the matches will be ranked 9-16 according to their seeding

Final Step 4

8 athletes will play 4 matches
The winners of the matches will continue to the Final Step 5
The losers of the matches will be ranked 5-8 according to their seeding

Final Step 5

4 athletes will play an elimination over 3 one game rounds, bowled one pair of lanes
The highest seeded athlete will decide his playing order first; then the second highest athlete will decide his playing order etc.
Each round is starting from scratch
In each round the lowest scoring athlete is leaving the elimination
The athlete leaving the first round will be ranked 4
The athletes leaving the second round will be ranked 3
The athletes losing the third round will be ranked 2
The winner will be ranked 1

Tournament tie rules

All Qualification competitions, excepts the Turbo

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

Final Step 1-5

In case of a tie in any game in any match, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

Lane assignments and lane movements
